

Request for Interest (RFI)

Licensed Therapists

The Family Justice Center (Center) is committed to ending and prevention interpersonal violence through coordinated community responses and providing holistic and innovative services to victims of violence. Recognizing that many of our clients need mental health counseling services to deal with their immediate crisis, we are seeking licensed professionals to provide competent mental health counseling services.

The intent of this Request for Interest (RFI) is to invite qualified individuals and organizations to submit a letter of interest that describes qualifications and their preferred hourly rate. We are looking for a therapist or therapists to provide counseling services one day a week at our West Center in Richmond and one day a week at our Central Center in Concord.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The selected candidate will be responsible for the following:

- Consult Family Justice Center Navigators on referral criteria and service needs.
- Conduct mental health assessments of clients referred by Navigators;
- Develop individualized treatments plans; and
- Conduct individual or group counseling sessions one full-day per week at each Center.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A license;
- Understanding of dynamics of interpersonal violence;
- Demonstrated experience in working with people from diverse backgrounds (ethnic, religious, social class, gender identity, sexual orientation etc.);
- Excellent interpersonal and problem-solving skills; and
- Bilingual Spanish speaker preferred.

DOCUMENT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit a Qualification Statement that includes:

- A statement that you or your organization is interested in performing the work;
- Your qualifications;
- Preferred hourly rate; and
- 3 professional references.
